## Connecting People, Places, and the Future

The Inglewood Transit Connector (ITC) Project is an approximately 1.6 mile fully elevated, automated transit system with three new stations in the City of Inglewood. The Project is estimated to support over 17,000 jobs and more than \$800M in labor income throughout the region\*.



## Critical First/Last Mile Connection

The Metro K Line will improve transit access to the City of Inglewood. The ITC project will link the broader Inglewood community to the regional light rail network with a state of the art first-mile/last-mile connection. It will be accessible to all and will provide Inglewood residents with streamlined access to the greater regional network without a car.

In addition to providing significant connectivity, the ITC Project will reduce vehicle traffic, renew economic growth and prosperity, and bring quality of life benefits to the City of Inglewood.
